## Contest Rules and Requirements:

- Artwork entry must be about our Aboriginal Peoples (First Nation, Métis and Inuit).
- Name, contest category, school name (if applicable) and contact information must be included on the back of the submission.
- Signed Entry Form with release. Note: parent/guardian required to sign Entry Form on behalf of entrants under the age of 18.
- Submission deadline is **Friday, June 15, 2018**.
- Art submissions will not be returned. Artwork can be picked up between June 25 – June 29, 2018 from Stony Plain Neighbourhood Centre: 4813-47 Avenue, Stony Plain, AB T7Z 1S2
- **Attention schools: If submitting artwork as part of a class project where similar pieces will be entered, please submit the top 5 pieces.**
